6. The park can be very windy so please make sure you secure your tent with tie downs / weights.
7. Event Hours: Sat, April 29, 11am – 6 pm (or until weigh in is over) Sun, April 30, 11am – 6 pm. Vendors are obligated to remain open during the event hours. All booths must be removed from the area on Sunday evening.
8. Vendors may start setting up at 9 a.m. and set-up must be completed and all vehicles removed from the area by 10:30 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday. Vehicles will not be allowed to return until after the event closes.
9. You are responsible for your own tent, tables and chairs.
10. There is limited power and no water. We encourage you to provide your own power.
11. Items left over night will be at your own risk.
12. All vendors are responsible for collecting and reporting the Florida Sales Tax.
